

Sub:- Migration of Railnet e-mail on NIC Server.

To implement "E-mail policy of Govt. of India " Railway Board vide letter No. 2010/Tele/TW/1/Data Network dtd. 01.10.2015 has advised for migration of Indian Railway Railnet e-mail to NIC Server at 11.00 AM on date 19th October 2015 retaining existing domain names, email ID along with old data.

The password for accessing the email will be changed according to the password policy of NIC. All the users of Railnet email having CUG mobile number will receive password on their mobile phone, one or two days before the migration takes place. The email services to the email users without CUG mobile number will be discontinued.


Email services are expected to remain disturbed during 19th. October 2015. Emails send to R-mail ID's may bounce back and users may face difficulty in sending emails from browser or client during migration period, which may last for around 7 days. During this period old email data will also be migrated to NIC server.

Use <http://nicmail.railnet.gov.in/> for accessing emails through web browsers after migration process and use complete email ID as user name.

Please follow and ensure the following new password policy of Govt. of India:-

- Change password, received through SMS immediately to ensure security of email account.
- The password shall contain more than eight characters.
- The password shall be a combination of upper and lower case characters (e.g.a-z, A-Z), digits (e.g. 0-9) and punctuation characters as well and other characters (e.g., ! @ # \$ % ^ & * () _ + | ~ - = \ ' } [] : " ; ' < > ? , . /).

Kindly arrange to give the wide publicity to all users of email in your department to avoid any inconvenience.
