

THE "SWACHH STATION" THEME OBSERVED ALL OVER WR ON THE 5TH DAY OF SWACHHATA PAKHWADA

The fifth day of SWACHHTA PAKHWADA was observed on Western Railway on 'SWACHHSTATION' theme on Sunday, 20th August 2017, wherein day long exercises were undertaken by intensive cleanliness drive at all stations other than A1 & A category of stations. During this drive, the focus was fully on to ensure segregation of waste by setting up of separate dustbins. Special drives were undertaken to clean-up and improve the station premises and circulating areas of railway stations on each Division. The teams of concerned officers inspected railway stations and circulating areas. The entire day was dedicated to cleanliness of the entire Railway station and its surroundings and it was ensured that the required amenities are provided in the circulating areas of station complexes. In Ahmedabad Division cleanliness drive was launched at Maninagar station. The volunteers of Samvedna Foundation also participated in the drive. The members of Ahmedabad station consultative Committee were also associated. Passenger interaction for obtaining feedback and awareness was also held. Swachhata Pledge was also administered to around 100 passengers and volunteers. In Rajkot Division Intensive cleanliness drive was carried out in the circulating area, platform and tracks at Bhaktinagar station of Rajkot station. Assistant Commercial Manager (Coaching) Miss Neelam Chouhan, Divisional Commercial Inspector Shri Amit Gutpa, Station Master of Bhaktinagar Shri Kamaljit Tiwari along with other Railway staff had actively participated in this drive.
