

## "SWACHH NEER" THEME OBSERVED ON THE 13<sup>th</sup> DAY OF SWACHHATA PAKHWADA BY WESTERN RAILWAY



On the thirteenth day of the Swachhata Pakwada, i.e. on 28th August, 2017, the theme was 'Swachh Neer' and various activities were undertaken including intensive inspection of water installations in offices, railway colonies, hospitals, health units and schools. The emphasis was to ensure that quality potable water is made available for passengers and there is no shortage of water supply at any of the passenger service location like waiting rooms, retiring rooms, platforms, trains etc. Inspection of water vending machines, water coolers was also undertaken for cleaning and samples were collected to check the quality of water. All efforts are being made to ensure that there is no problem of water stagnation anywhere in railway premises. Water samples were collected by Medical officers and Chief Health Inspectors from catering units and other drinking water outlets. Working of water filters at catering units were also checked with its AMC.
