

## THE "SWACHH AAHAAR" THEME OBSERVED ALL OVER WR ON THE 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> DAY OF SWACHHATA PAKHWADA



The tenth & eleventh day of “Swachhta Pakhwada” was observed on Western Railway on 'SWACHH AAHAAR' theme on Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 & Saturday, 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, wherein intensive cleaning of all canteens at all A1, A & B category stations alongwith station vending units were taken. Intensive cleaning was also undertaken in all pantry cars in trains. All catering units were ensure to provide clean and hygienic food and environment at static and mobile catering units, restaurants, food stalls and other catering services at stations as well as pantry cars in trains. Samples of food were taken for checking and feedback of passengers were obtained on the quality of food served. In Mumbai Division, Catering Units were inspected under the guidance of Sr. Divisional Medical Officer of Borivali. Vendors were educated about cleanliness and personal hygiene. Extensive cleaning of Boisar station was also done. In Rajkot Division, Sr. Divisional Operations Manager, Rajkot Division carried out the inspection of catering stalls at Rajkot station along with Commercial Inspector. They also checked base kitchen of food plaza at Rajkot station. Detailed inspection of pantry car of Train no 16337 Okha- Ernakulam Express was conducted by Health Inspector of Rajkot.
