With the ongoing theme of 'Swachh Railgadi' in the forthcoming celebration of "Swachhta Hi Sewa Pakhwada", Smt. Vidya Thakur - Hon'ble Minister of State for Women and Child Development, Govt. Of Maharashtra & Shri A K Gupta - GM/W.Rly participated in cleanliness drive organised at Ram Mandir station on 21st September, 2018. On this occasion, a Flash mob was conducted and organized by volunteers and artists of Rotary Club at Ram Mandir station. Also, a "No plastic campaign" was conducted at Goregaon station and passengers found carrying polythene/ plastic bags were handed cloth bags by the members of Rotary club.

According to a press release issued by Shri Ravinder Bhakar – Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Railway, on the seventh day of "Swachhta Hi Sewa Pakhwada" in Mumbai Division of Western Railway, Officers and supervisory staff were deputed on trains for conducting and organizing cleanliness and awareness activities. The drive was organized during train maintenance and at platforms during dispatch by involving 11 Coaching Depot Officers of Mechanical as well as Electrical departments, Supervisors, staff, etc. Similarly, cleanliness awareness campaign & anti-malarial activities were carried out in railway colony at Dadar undertaken by Health Inspectors staff teams. Dr. Sandhya Rani, ADMO - Mumbai Central, inspected train no. 19015 Saurashtra Express as a part of Swachh Rail at Mumbai Central station. The coaches of the train were inspected randomly and all rest rooms were found to be

The exterior of train was clean and no stain or dirt was found and all the dustbins were with garbage bags.
